

ALFRED ALMOND ALUMNI SPORT HALL OF FAME AWARD

Qualification and Nomination Procedures

PURPOSE

- The Committee's purpose is to seek and nominate worthy candidates for enshrinement in the Sports Hall of Fame.
- To help preserve the history of the Alfred Almond Central School athletic program.
- To preserve, strengthen and add distinction to the athletic program at Alfred Almond Central School.
- To nominate and elect individuals or groups who through participation, support or interest have made outstanding contributions to the Alfred Almond Central School athletic program and school community.

CANDIDATES

The nominees shall have demonstrated excellent performance in inter-scholastic athletic achievement, included but not limited to Championships, Medals, Awards, Recognition and Testimonials offered by teammates and coaches.

The nominees shall be Athletes, Coaches or Contributors of AACS whose outstanding contributions merit special recognition by the Alfred Almond Alumni Association (AAAA). Nominees must exemplify the highest standards of sportsmanship, ethical conduct, and character. All candidates will be judged on their significant and/or long-term contributions to Alfred Almond Central School athletics.

SPORT HALL OF FAME COMMITTEE

The Sports Hall of Fame Committee comprises seven (7) members, chosen by the Board, to serve staggered 3 year terms. The Committee may have non-members with the understanding said non-members are/were employed by AACS. The President shall appoint the Committee chair.

The Committee shall offer its nomination for approval by the Board, with full dossier or biography of the nominee no later than December 31st

SELECTION PROCESS

Athletes

- Nominations may come from any source to any Committee member.

- Nominations will be accepted after the required 5 year waiting period from the time of high school graduation.
- Candidates must have attended Alfred Almond Central School and participated in interscholastic sports for at least 3 years.

Coaches/Contributors

- Nominations will be accepted after the required 10 year waiting period from the time of initial contribution to Alfred Almond.
- Successful seasons and consistent contribution to the athletic program at Alfred Almond Central School.
- Contributions to the Alfred Almond Athletic program must be considered extraordinary and outstanding.

The Committee members shall meet at a time determined by the Chairman in order to nominate, review, and elect candidates. The quorum for any meeting at which election of candidates shall take place shall be a majority of members. Background information on each nominee should be distributed to Committee members prior to the meeting and members should familiarize themselves with the nominees prior to voting. Each Committee member shall have one vote and all votes shall carry equal weight. In order to gain election, a candidate is required to receive a number of votes equal to 75% of those members present at the meeting. The outcome of the vote will be shared with the Committee members only.

This Committee shall offer its nomination(s) for consideration and approval by the Alfred Almond Alumni Association Board. All Committee data is the property of the AAAA and upon request, shall be delivered to the Board.

Alfred Almond Alumni Association Board Secretary will notify honored inductees with a formal letter of congratulations and induction ceremony details.

Induction Ceremony

The induction ceremony shall be at the annual Alumni Association Banguet where the inductees and families will be recognized.
